6.1.2 DA 740/0008/13 – IG & AF Pratt – Shelter Shed (existing building, outside toilet and change of land use to recreational horse riding)

David Hutchison discussed the history of the Application, of his thorough investigation with the Development Plan and the environmental issues with the current location of the toilet facility requiring removal of vegetation for the soakage area.
