6.4 DISTRICT COUNCIL OF PETERBOROUGH

6.4.1 DA 504/020/13 – Robert Collinge – 18m high mast and antennas for wireless internet connection

An inspection of the property was undertaken by Panel Members prior to the Meeting.

11.15am – Mr Daniel Upton, Representor was permitted to address the Panel:

Mr Daniel Upton tendered an apology for Jacinta Lannstrom who had indicated a desire to be heard personally.

Mr Upton, a nearby resident to the proposal, outlined his concerns with the proposal:

- He lives within 150 metres of the proposed tower and the school will be within 100 metres. He raised concern with the unknown health risks to nearby people caused by radiation from the tower.
- The visual aspect of the proposal.

Questions were asked of Mr Upton by Panel Members which were answered.



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11.22am – Mr Don Collinge on behalf of the applicant, Robert Collinge, was permitted to address Mr Upton's concerns and answer any further questions that the Panel may have:

Mr Collinge advised the following:

- The tower will use a Wi-Fi signal.
- Technical experts have confirmed that it is a safe transmission level which have been monitored by different bodies.
- Wi-Fi technology is already used within the School grounds.
- The tower will provide full coverage to the town by this 18 metre tower.
- It will be a safer signal than what is being used currently with the 9.5 metre tower.
- A slender pole has been chosen as it is less intrusive.
- The tower construction and appearance was publicised on Facebook which received good feedback.
- Receivers will be needed at resident's homes (eg chimney attachment).
- Base pole of the mast will be the same as the existing mast but with more guy wires which will be all contained within the property.

That Development Application 504/020/13 seeking construction of an 18m high mast at 72 South Terrace Peterborough, not being seriously at variance with the provisions of the District Council of Peterborough Development Plan, be **granted** Consent, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The development shall proceed in accordance with the plans and details submitted with and forming part of Development Application No. 504/020/13.
- 2. Any cabling associated with the facility shall be affixed to and as close as possible to the mast.
- 3. The antenna affixed to the mast shall painted or otherwise finished in a dull, flat grey colour such as cadet grey or similar.
- 4. All construction work is to be carried out to the satisfaction of Council at all times.
